Executive Summary:

A 2-year long, independent USNI pilot investigation exposes the existence of a possibly Serbo-Croatian air force intelligence agent (Tulok) and Pan-Slav "mole operation" (dubbed "ProbeDemon") conducted at Essex County Airport, New Jersey since 1999. This suspected multi-element Pan-Slavic Nationalist MOG (military operations group) is believed by this analyst to be guilty of subversion and sabotage, which caused the plane crash and the death of John F. Kennedy Jr., his wife and passenger on July 16th, 1999. The motives appear to have been Pan-Slavic Nationalist terrorist revenge for the "War in Yugoslavia" (1999) and self-aggrandizement on the part of the leader, Zoltan Tulok. Tulok, ostensibly Hungarian, has claimed himself to be a former Czechoslovakian Air Force jet pilot but could be Serbo-Croatian or Russian. "ProbeDemon" is the Internet name of a suspected accomplice in the sabotage, a 16-year-old boy, surnamed "Probirzynski". Third and fourth elements are confirmed but as yet "unidentified". A preliminary report has been made to the Federal Aviation Agency.
